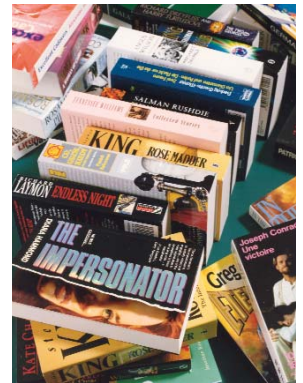
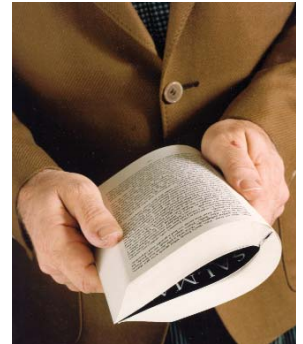


Fact

For quality bookbinding operations, adhesives need to be clean, easy to use, odourless and not fume.

BAMFutura was developed

to meet these criteria. The adhesives are pearl white in colour, with the purity of their raw materials bringing high thermal stability that prevents degradation

during use – see graph.

This means that they will run

cleanly and efficiently over a long period. They remain stable, do not char or gel and therefore ensure a consistent application of adhesion across the spine.

BAMFutura hot melts have been formulated to work equally well in cold winter or hot summer conditions and achieve high page pulls on a wide range of paper and cover stocks.

They will work on all types of bookbinding machines, with fast melt down rates and without stringing.

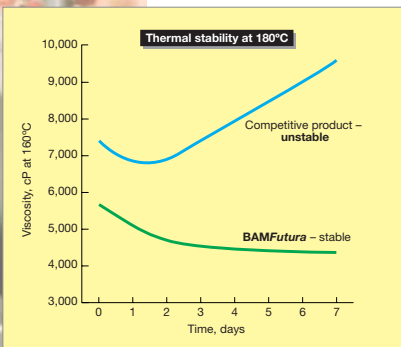
BAMFutura hot melts are also virtually odourless and do not fume, making them more pleasant to work with.



Nozzle blockages caused by degradation of the adhesive in the melt tank is a common problem with standard hot melts – eliminated when using BAMFutura hot melts because of the resistance to oxidation built into the product.

BAMFutura is so versatile that the range requires only four hot melts to satisfy most gluing applications:

BAMFutura 101 A versatile, general purpose water white adhesive ideally suited for one shot binding. Can be applied at 125°C. Use it for bonding books, magazines, catalogues and directory spines.

BAMFutura 101W A white pigmented

version of BAMFutura 101 – for when an opaque white colour is required.

BAMFutura 102 Has a very speedy set and is ideally suited to faster hot melt binders for fast in-line trimming. It has a high tensile strength to enable high page pull values. For fast in-line trimming, especially in hot climates.

BAMFutura 103 Long open time side glue with low odour, excellent thermal stability and good adhesion to a wide range of cover and paper stock.
